Copyright Owners' Exclusive Rights:

Reproduce

Distribute

Perform

Display

Prepare Derivative Works



Copyright Best Practices

Do not use third-party works in business materials unless:

Those works are in the public domain;

or

Permission is obtained from the copyright owner, and the use falls within the scope of that permission.



Requesting Permission from the Copyright Owner

- Identify and contact the owner of the copyright.
- Budget time to obtain permission.
- Know the limits of your desired license.
- Get the license in writing.



Fair Use Factors

- Purpose and character of the use.
- Nature of the copyrighted work.
- Amount of the work used.
- Potential market for the work.
